

## DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

**WHEREAS**, the City of Aransas Pass on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2017, declared a disaster of widespread or severe damage from Hurricane Harvey to property from flooding and hurricane force wind and;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City of Aransas Pass has determined that extraordinary measures must continue to prevent and to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ARANSAS PASS

1. That a state of disaster continues for the City of Aransas Pass.
2. That the City Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue until April 2, 2018 Regular City Council Meeting.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
