Title: Consider and Act on awarding the Request for Proposals for Shrimporee Building Repairs

PURPOSE:

The Shrimporee Building sustained damages due to Hurricane Harvey in August 2017. With Council approval, the City went out for bids and received a total of three bids from contractors.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS: Since the Shrimporee Building was damaged by Hurricane Harvey it should be eligible for FEMA reimbursement. However, before FEMA funds can be released to the City, this purchase must follow certain Federal guidelines. It is important to make repairs to the building prior to the Shrimporee event as it is used by the Chamber as the main information center and by Aransas Pass PD for Security Outpost.

Staff is recommending awarding the bid to Geofill Materials Technologies in an amount not to exceed \$80,828.00.
