

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-859**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ARANSAS PASS, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE ARANSAS COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT'S REQUEST TO ANNEX TO THE HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, City of Aransas Pass has experienced natural disasters that have resulted in public hazards and damage to private and public property; and

**WHEREAS**, participating jurisdictions, including the City of Aransas Pass, adopted the Hazard Mitigation Action Plan (Plan) in December 2017 and received notification of approval of the Plan by FEMA effective February 1, 2018 through January 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the hazard mitigation planning process set forth by FEMA and the State of Texas offers the opportunity to consider natural hazards and risks, and to identify mitigation actions to reduce future risk; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aransas County Navigation District meets all of the conditions and requirements of FEMA regulations which allow for additional jurisdictions to be annexed into the adopted Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aransas County Navigation District has met the public notice and meeting Requirements to Annex to the Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the effective dates of the Plan will not be affected by the Aransas County Navigation District's annex to the Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, all participating jurisdictions have reviewed the Plan Annex and found that it meets the planning criteria found in 44 CFR Part 201.6.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARANSAS PASS, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** That it supports the addition of the Aransas County Navigation District as a participating jurisdiction of the Hazard Mitigation Action Plan which is in effect from February 1, 2018 through January 31, 2023.

**Section 2.** That it supports the Aransas County Navigation District's request to annex to the Hazard Mitigation Action Plan.
